1988 Copy of the passing of ownership of Aleph-Yissum from Yissum to the Hebrew University. Dated March 9th 1988, it is the protocol under Michel's chairmanship. It is mentioned that Hebrew University gets 60000 shares for passing the right to use the software to Aleph Yissum. Michel did not put the value since this was a private deal. It does mention a PC version that would be (not in 89 as planned.)..achieved years later.

1990 Letter from Avner Navin to Azriel Morag reminding him that he has no exclusivity on the Unix versions of Aleph.

1993 Azriel's fax to Pazy, then president of the University, offering 1M dollar for the company. He underlines that he is making a real effort and is being generous with this offer.
